### **Volunteer Forms**

A wonderful part of being a Waldorf parent is the wonderful connection that is

fostered through volunteering and being an active part of your child's education! Teachers appreciate the help in the classrooms whether it is through sharing a cultural holiday, an area of expertise or through chaperoning a field trip. Be prepared at a moments notice by completing the necessary paperwork now.

Parent volunteers in the classroom must complete a Volunteer Agreement and must undergo a "volunteer level" background check. Getting a Livescan as soon as possible is highly recommended. Results can be delayed due to fingerprint quality or other unforeseen issues. A Livescan only needs to be done once for your entire time here at Davis Waldorf School and is required for all overnight field trips. In addition, getting Livescanned early saves the school time and money, as the volunteer background checks need to be completed each year.


### **Strings Camp**
